

LUXEMBOURG SPACE STRATEGY - 4 PILLARS


- SKILLS: building a talent pool for a new economy

- **INNOVATION**: nurturing entrepreneurial space research and business
 - 80 research projects: University of Luxembourg & LIST
- **FUNDING**: financing the future space economy
 - LuxIMPULSE (public): help companies to bring innovative ideas to market
 - Space fund: standalone investment instrument for promising space tech,
