- No pre-knowledge necessary

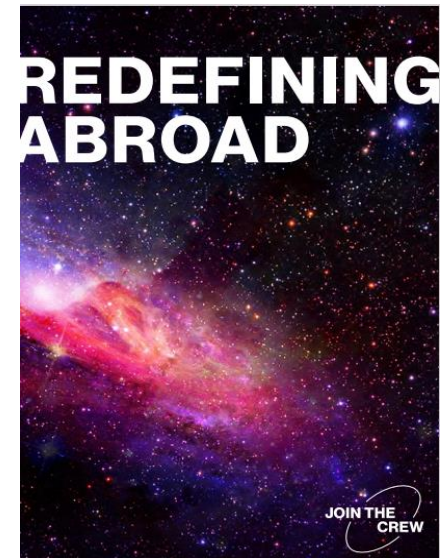

One week in Düsseldorf (19. - 23. June 2023 & mobility funded by Erasmus+) followed by a two-week online and asynchronous project.

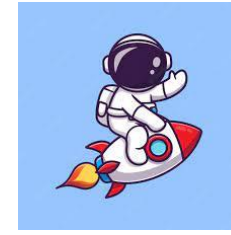
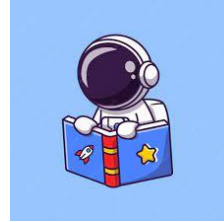
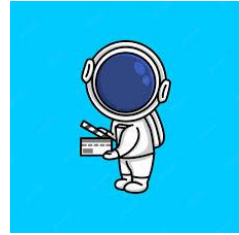
### Why should you participate?

## Workshops
